As we enter into the month of November, something changes in most of us. We recognize immediately that with November change is on the way. The days get shorter and shorter. Sandals are traded in for closed toe shoes, short sleeve shirts for sweaters, fall jackets for something a bit heavier. Many set up appointments to change tires for "the season." As your pastor, let me encourage all of us to make these two months about gathering and celebrating. If you can make it, let's be in the building...together. When we do things together everything is multiplied. Like instruments, a single instrument can make a nice sound, but when we put all the instruments together, we become a harmonious band. I'm envisioning two of the best months of the year...but for that to happen we need YOU!! And while you're at it, bring a friend. Bring on November and December. We're ready!!
