IT'S TIME: TIME FOR CHRISTMAS

The time has come!! It's time to turn the page in the wonderful story of God back to page one. It's time to start again a story that miraculously unfolds, beginning now and running through Pentecost. The story of Redemption. The story of unparalleled love. The story of a God who, from the moment of the Fall of Mankind in the Garden of Eden, refused to let us go. Yes, a lot of history took place before the birth of Christ, but time changed for everyone when God set in motion the Redemption Plan He knew would change the world.

I've always loved the way Paul puts it in Galations 4:4-7. These words come to my mind almost instantly every year when we flip the pages of God's salvation story back to page one. Paul writes, "But when the time had fully come, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. Because you are a son, God sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls our, 'Abba, Father.' So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir."

"When the time had fully come..." The time of Christ's coming was not conditioned by human readiness. In these verses it says that Christ came when mankind was still bound in law. Paul in Romans 5 informs us that Christ came and eventually died: 1) when we were still powerless (v.6); 2) when we were still sinners (v.8), 3) when we were God's enemies (v.10). We are reminded repeatedly in the Scriptures that Christ's coming to the world was not based upon human merit but Divine Grace! Paul simply

says, "It was time." I love that!!

Three days from the time of my writing this article we will push back from the Thanksgiving table, once again feeling too full. Then three days later Advent begins. The first theme of Advent is HOPE. Our hope has a source seen first in the miraculous birth of Christ – the grand entrance of Divine Rescue. By the time Jesus' stay on earth comes to a close, He will rise back to heaven having accomplished everything needed to offer all HOPE. He will wipe out the power and punishment of sin. He will transform those who accept His forgiveness from the status of slaves to sons. He will set in motion the infilling of our lives with the Holy Spirit. And He will announce us as heirs...heirs to God's blessings, provisions, care, comfort, and ultimately Heaven.

"Merry Christmas" doesn't quite capture all the wonder. It's our job to fill in the gaps; to rediscover the wonder and miracle of Christmas. It's our job to in speak the words "Merry Christmas" as more than a simple greeting, but rather a blessing. IT'S TIME!! LET US CELEBRATE!! LET US CELEBRATE JESUS!!
