PASTOR'S PONDERINGS:

WITH GOD, ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE!!

We say this, and I'm certain that every time we say it, we honestly believe it. That said, I think I can safely say that there have been times when I've made this statement, and if totally honest, in my heart I've said it more as a "hope" than a declaration of faith. Anyone else willing to admit that with me? When staring at something that seems to be impossible, faith is critically important, but when faith is hard to fully embrace, I think it's OK to hold on to hope as a pathway to faith. In fact, knowing how gracious God is, in my heart I must believe that God views our feelings of hope as declarations of faith. And then as hope finds new evidence in God's faithfulness, full faith rises.

On October 13th, at the end of our service, the question was asked, "What are some of the barriers or limitations preventing us from becoming all God wants us to be at Parkside Church of the Nazarene?" In a time of great honesty, fourteen items were mentioned. Among them were things like, "we're too small" or "we're too old" or "we're too financially strapped." Others were things like "our work force is just too small" or "those who are working hard are feeling burnt out." Other critical items mentioned were conditions of "apathy" or "fear" or... here it is: "weak faith." (The full list is available in the foyer.)

So, let me begin with this: every one of the items mentioned by different attenders are true. We are small...for now. We are older as a congregation...but we can become younger. We are a bit more strapped financially than we've been in the past...but God is still providing. Our work force is limited...but more people can step up if they will. Our workers are tired...and what would help is if reenforcements would get involved. There are feelings of great concern: there is fear. All of these things are true, but they are not the final word!!

As your pastor, there are two items on the list that stand out. The first is apathy. Apathy by definition is "a lack of interest, enthusiasm, or concern." Simply put, it's not caring. My prayer is that God will help us as a church to see what is happening and care deeply, passionately, actively. This is why there is a call to prayer; it's saying to God that we see what is happening and we need His help. God wants us to care deeply!

The second is "weak faith." As our leadership team met this past Sunday, we spent a good amount of time looking over the list of limitations and making comments. In the end, this is where your leadership landed: We need to determine that the list created by the congregation is not a list of limitations, BUT RATHER, a list of 14 arenas where God can perform miracles. I believe that what your leadership collectively did on Sunday was to turn our focus from limitations to FAITH!! Fourteen items listed, and every one of them arenas for God to do the miraculous!

WITH GOD, ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE! Collectively, let us embrace this with faith...or at the very least, hope as the pathway to faith. God help us. Miracles are on the way!!!


